Learner Achievement Award

Criteria

1. The learner is an adult.
2. The recipient is enrolled in a basic literacy program not exceeding a GED level or high school diploma. This is not a scholarship for post-secondary education.
3. The learner is planning to continue in the program.
4. The learner has been a part of the program for at least six months.
5. The learner has a strong commitment to their learning goals.
6. The learner has made considerable or excellent progress.
7. The learner's application has the written support of their tutor or instructor.
8. The learner must complete the application letter. They may have the assistance of their tutor or instructor.
9. The learner lives in Saskatoon or within 100 kilometres of city.

The application letter must contain the following information:

- Name
- Address
- Phone number
- Date
- Name of the literacy program you are involved with.
- When did you start in the Program?
- What have you been the activities you have been working on?
- What areas of your learning are you most proud of?
- What is your plan for the future?

- Letter of support from your tutor or instructor
