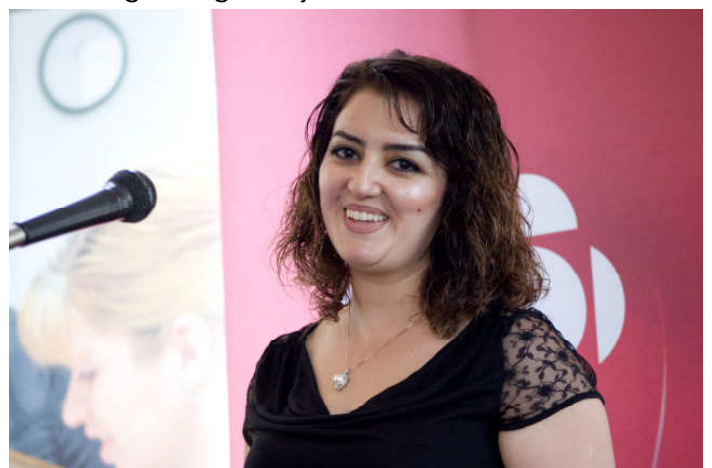
Because of Jodi's heavy work load at READ Saskatoon, she could not continue to be my tutor.
